

Proposed constitutional amendments

In § 11 Composition and management of affairs:

Clause 1, as it stands:

- 1) The board consists of a president, the vice-president, the treasurer and a changing number of student representatives. Nobody may hold more than one position at a time.

Proposed change:

- 1) The board consists of a president, the vice-president, the treasurer, **the social rep**, and a changing number of student representatives. Nobody may hold more than one position at a time.

Clause 4, as it stands:

- 4) The term of a member of the board ends when he leaves the association. If a member of the board leaves the association before his term ends, the remaining members of the board shall elect a substitute member for the rest of his term, unless the member in question is the president. In this event, a new board shall be elected within 10 working days.

Proposed change:

- 4) The term of a member of the board ends when he leaves the association. If a member of the board leaves the association before his term ends, the remaining members of the board shall elect a substitute member for the rest of his term, unless the member in question is the president. In this event, a new **president** shall be elected within 10 working days.

In § 13 Board Resolutions:

Clause 2, as it stands:

- 2) The president, the vice-president and the treasurer each have one vote. The student representatives of the M.P.P. students have one vote per year (in total two votes). The student representatives of the M.I.A students have one vote per year (in total two votes). The student representatives of the E.M.P.M. students have, in total, one vote. Likewise, the student representatives of the PhD students have, in total, one vote.

Proposed change:

- 2) The president, the vice-president, the treasurer, **and the social rep** shall each have one vote. The student representatives of the M.P.P. students have one vote per year (in total two votes). The student representatives of the M.I.A students have one vote per year (in total two votes). The student representatives of the E.M.P.M. students have, in total, one vote. Likewise, the student representatives of the PhD students have, in total, one vote.
